

Comaker vs. Cosigner

According to NCUA (National Credit Union Association), a comaker is someone that signs on a loan and benefits from the loan, while a cosigner guarantees the loan but does not benefit from the proceeds. A comaker is required to also be a member of the credit union, while a cosigner is not. To be a member of the credit union, an individual must maintain a share (saving) account with a minimal balance of \$5.00.

The Board of Directors recently amended our Bylaws, to permit a joint owner on an account to be considered a member (without having to open another account), as long as the account maintains a minimum balance of \$10. If the comaker is not a joint owner/member on the original account, he or she will be required to maintain a separate account.

We realize this is confusing, but it is necessary to meet our federal regulations. If you are not sure, ask any employee for clarification.

Member Tips on Reducing or Stopping Fraud:

- Sign up for transaction alerts to monitor for unauthorized transactions—via our website
- Pay attention to emails, links, and websites. Think before you click.
- Ensure computers, laptops and mobile devices are protected with antivirus, anti-spyware and a firewall.
- Close shopping websites or turn off computer, tablet, or mobile device.
- Be cautious when using ATMs or gas pumps for skimming or shimming devices. For gas pumps, try to use the pump closest to the entrance as they are less likely to be a target for skimmers. Be on the lookout for ATM tampering. Always survey your surroundings for safety.
- Review your accounts daily and report any discrepancies immediately.
- Beware of people asking for payment in the form of prepaid cards, gift cards, wire transfers, or going through a 3rd party. These types of payments are typically not traceable.
